Academics

At Eagle Elementary, we take a “Student Centered” approach to learning, which provides students with voice and choice in their education. Instructionally we offer a rigorous school curriculum that is taught by dedicated educators who have received recent and ongoing professional development. This includes the following curricular programs and practices:

Literacy-

For literacy instruction a Balanced Literacy program is utilized, with focused reading and writing lessons from Units of Study developed by Lucy Calkins and The Teachers College. This includes explicit instruction in spelling, grammar, handwriting, and key-boarding.

Math-

We have recently adopted the new edition of Math Expressions in order to meet current State Standards. Students are provided with a variety of instructional methods and are actively engaged in the learning process.

Science-

Eagle Elementary is in its first year of implementing Discover Education for science instruction. This program provides a comprehensive standards-based content, professional development, Digital Science Techbooks, and streaming video content which allows students to utilize PEASD technology in the learning process.

Social Studies-

Social Studies instruction is currently focused upon the Wisconsin Model Academic Standards. Students learn about content that is centered around the five strands of social studies: behavioral science, economics, geography, history, and political science.

Education Enrichment

Instructional opportunities are differentiated, so that educators can effectively plan for student differences. In a differentiated classroom, teachers divide their time, resources, and efforts to effectively teach students who have various backgrounds, skill levels, and interests. Advanced learners are able to receive personalized learning opportunities that match their skill levels and passions.

Technology

Eagle Elementary students have access to:

- SMART Boards in every classroom
- ChromeBooks or iPads in all classrooms (Each classroom has a 1:2 ratio (meaning one device per two students). There are Chromebooks in the library for checkout to classrooms that want to have a 1:1 ratio.
- A state of the art Makerspace with: a 3D Printer, Lego Robotics, Osmo, and more.
- Document Cameras in all classrooms.
