**Community service** is a donated service or activity that is performed by someone or a group of people for the benefit of the public or its institutions.

The Service Recognition Program at Palmyra-Eagle High School is designed to recognize those students who have given outstanding service to the school and community during their high school years (9th-12th grade). Students who accumulate at least 200 hours of service during their high school years will be awarded the white service cord during the senior award's ceremony before their graduation. Service hours must not be for credit, for pay or used to work off legal penalties. At least 100 of the hours must be service work other than aiding for a teacher.
