1. Curriculum/Instruction/Assessment

Kathy Retzke and I have worked to bring a math coach in on November 13th to work with all three of our math teachers. Steven Mijajlovic, a math coach from CESA2, will spend time with each of the math teachers in the district and then have an opportunity to work with them during their preps. From there we will develop a plan to continue coaching opportunities as we feel is necessary.

Math and English teachers are currently looking at Fastbridge data. They will use this data to get more background on their students abilities in their classrooms and use the data to find ways to help their students be successful in the classroom.
