1. Curriculum/Instruction/Assessment

Teachers have spent their first two rounds of PLC time working on their PPG and SLOs for the school year. This year we have decided to focus on teaching strategies for professional growth goals. Teachers have done a self-assessment using Dr. Robert Marzono's <u>developmental scales</u>. They will then pick a focus element personal and one for their content area to focus on during the school year. In addition, we will be doing a school-wide SLO on social-emotional learning tied to school climate and culture. We hope to utilize the data to provide students with positive and meaningful experiences during the school year.

The FastBridge universal screener in math and ELA was given to all 7th - 10th grade students. This data will be used to determine students who might be in need of extra support either in the classroom or during resource in an intervention placement.
