1. Curriculum/Instruction/Assessment

- All of the testing for the year is completed. Thanks to all of the teachers and administrators for being flexible during testing times and making sure our students were prepared. This year, the following state assessments were given:

PALS (early literacy)	Grades K4-2	October, January, May
WCKE Science and Social Studies	Grades 4, 8, 10	October
Access (ELL)	All identified students	December
ACT Aspire	Grade 9	October, May
ACT Aspire	Grade 10	May
ACT	Grade 11	May

Dynamic Learning Maps (Special Education)	Grades 3-11	October, May
- In addition to state assessments, there were also district assessments that were given.
- Teachers in kindergarten through grade 6 will receive new curriculum binders that include their grade level's English/language arts curriculum along with instructional timelines.
- Summer school is being finalized. Right now, I am projecting 270 students for summer school. Last year's enrollment was 292. We will be running 9 offerings at the middle/high school along with credit recovery classes. We will be running 36 offerings at the elementary school. A separate memo to the Board outlines the teachers who are proposed for hire for summer school. Once again, a shuttle will run from Palmyra to Eagle and back to Palmyra in order for students from both communities are able to attend.
