Whereas, the District sought, by referendum held on April 2, 2019, to exceed the state imposed revenue limits on a non-recurring basis for four (4) years totaling 11.5 million dollars; and Whereas, the referendum failed to pass; and

Wereas, the District's financial condition calls into questions its ability to continue to operate. Now, Therefore, be it resolved by the School Board of the Palmyra-Eagle Area School District that:

- 1. The Board consider dissolving the school district.
- 2. All steps necessary to continue and complete the dissolution process be taken in a timely manner as provided for in Wisconsin Statutes, Chapter 117.
