- 1. Update from C&I Coordinator Discussed throughout the rest of the agenda items.
- 2. Update & discussion on progress of plan to address DPI report card/Fastbridge results met with middle school PLCs, continuing to work through the large amount of data.
- 3. Discussion on AVID visit and next steps admin team had their site visit. Learned a lot. Currently working on developing a team. Would like to introduce it to the middle school first and then move forward to the entire school. Avid in general is a return to basic study skills. Looking at all of the pieces and picking which ones to start with.
- 4. Discussion on Instructing teachers how to use FASTBridge results to form whole group instruction instructional plans, and small group instruction met with middle school PLCs, continuing to work through the large amount of data.
- 5. Discussion of New HS math course- Integrated Math this would be a trades based math to include review of Algebra 1, geometry & pull basics from Algebra 2. Offered as an alternative to Algebra 2. Admin/counselor will work with student/families to decide which is the right course for for them and their future plans. Ideal vision would be classroom one day, and apply in tech Ed the next. Would be a dual teacher course. Committee recommends moving to the full board for approval.
- 6. Update & discussion on Finalizing HS math resource for next year (Kendall Hunt Illustrative Math or HMH Integrated AGA) current HS math program is outdated. Math PLC group has narrowed it down to 2 choices and are currently testing these two out. Will have a final decision sometime in May, and bring to C&P along with a better idea of price.
- 7. Discussion of Vertical elem/middle school science team formed to look at science resources (K-6 program, 7-8 program) a group of elementary & middle school teachers was formed to look at science resources. Our current resources are up and it was chosen not to renew.
- 8. Discussion of Summer Professional Development summer professional development. Discussed learning options for our staff. Vision would be to offer up to 5 days, with the goal that all teachers would complete at least one of the learning opportunities. The committee requested that it be moved to finance for further discussion on stipend details, budgeting and esser funds for the 22/23 school year.
- 9. Discussion of Ed Camp @ EES Beginning to do Ed camps once a month at staff meeting. Basically teachers teaching other teachers on areas they love/do well/teacher well.

- 10. Discussion of Educator Effectiveness book study groups teachers were grouped by their fields.

 Together they choose a book on or in support of their field. Then they come together to review, brainstorm, etc. Once a month
