 - B. Summer scholars update - 110 students are enrolled, only 16 middle school students. Almost doubled from enrollment at this point last year. 38 for wrap-around care. Will move to the board for approval.
 - C. HS Math Resources/Curriculum - Curriculum & Instruction director spoke about all of the programs they are researching for future math classes. Have a couple of options and will test them out.
 - D. Elementary/Middle School Science Curriculum - C&I continued the discussion about science curriculum options that are being investigated for next year.
 - E. Diesel Program - Tech Ed teacher has been in contact with everyone she can think could help us with this. Looking into which parts we would want the students to study. Have been researching digital curriculum as well. Will use all of this to decide where to start with our introductory course. Waiting for a tech school to take a look at facilities to see what we have to work with.
 - F. Review district curriculum binders - Elementary Principal brought in copies of grade curriculum binders. These binders lay out what each grade level is supposed to achieve in the school year. These are a baseline, a starting point for the teachers. Further resources are used to create the entire curriculum. The goal is to have programs for each subject to streamline for the teachers. Also discussed the search for a phonics program to be implemented.
