Each year, *THE JANESVILLE GAZETTE* and radio stations WCLO and WJVL take pleasure in offering financial assistance in memory of Harry H. Bliss, respected publisher of *THE JANESVILLE GAZETTE* until his death in 1937.

HARRY H. BLISS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS are intended to assist graduating seniors in *THE JANESVILLE GAZETTE*-WCLO/WJVL market area who plan to prepare for a career in Communications and Journalism. Preference will be given to those applicants who express special interest in fields such as news writing and reporting, editorial writing, editing, news photography, advertising, broadcast announcing and production, broadcast engineering, or other areas having application in communications media.

Applicants for HARRY H. BLISS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS are to be in the upper fifty percent of their graduating class. *THE JANESVILLE GAZETTE*-WCLO/WJVL Scholarship Committee will give serious consideration to the applicant's school and community citizenship accomplishments and extra-curricular participation.

Although financial need is not a principal criterion in the selection of the Scholarship recipients, the Committee reserves the right to consider this factor in those cases involving applicants whose qualifications are equal in other respects.

THE JANESVILLE GAZETTE-WCLO/WJVL Scholarship Committee will make application forms available to area high school authorities and to area students who request them. Only those students who complete the HARRY H. BLISS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP form will be considered for the awards. Applicants must agree, if requested, to appear before the Committee for a personal interview at its Janesville offices. The completed application form is to be delivered or mailed to *THE JANESVILLE GAZETTE*-WCLO/WJVL Scholarship Committee by April 1. All applicants will be notified of the Committee's Scholarship selections on or about May 1.

A check will be issued upon receipt of proof of completion of second semester registration and a copy of first semester grades.
